COVID-19 Attendance Plan @ Athletic Events

1. Face coverings are required by all attendees, event workers, and event personnel. Face coverings can be removed to eat or drink.
2. Attendance will be limited to 250 people per indoors & 500 outdoors available according to state of Indiana and IHSAA COVID-19 Guidelines. Attendance will be limited to 250 per side for outdoor events. Crawford County will be sending out vouchers for home and away outdoor events. Families may sit together, but must maintain social distance from other family units.
 - * High School Gym - Every other row of the bleachers will be left vacant during volleyball games. Both sides of the bleachers will be opened if needed to accommodate 250 maximum people.
 - * Fans can bring lawn chairs to football games, tennis & cross country matches
3. Restroom facilities will be open for football, tennis & cross Country & fans. School restrooms in the gym will be open for volleyball.
4. Doors and all ticket gates will open 30-45 minutes before the event.
 - * Ticket takers must wear face covering and gloves
5. Concessions will be available as pre-packaged. This does include hamburgers, popcorn, hot dogs, nachos as long as these are safely handled prior to packaging. * Concessions stands are limited to only Essential personnel working. All workers must wear face masks and gloves. * Concession stand lines will have markings for social distancing.
6. Hand sanitizers will be available throughout buildings.
7. Only Essential personnel on sidelines or team benches.
8. Social distancing is required when standing in line for tickets, restrooms, or concession stand lines.
9. Crawford County reserves the right to ask any patron to leave, not abiding by or complying with these requests
